

Subject: Rule Change Effective Immediately

If a coach cannot control their sidelines or themselves in the game that coach is to receive: A single caution from the official, noting that the 2nd caution will result in ejection.

Upon second caution, the coach is to be immediately ejected from the game.

**Penalty for ejection is \$100 fine AND a one-game suspension.**

The \$100 fine is the responsibility of the COACH, and must be paid to LCYSA.

If the coach refuses to pay, the club must pay LCYSA. The **coach** will **not** be allowed to participate within any D7 (club, association, district) leagues again.

If the club refuses to pay, then the **club** will not be allowed to play in LCYSA or D7 leagues.

The purpose of this proposal is to protect the game officials and allow for healthy competition.

This proposal is in line with LCYSA's Mission Statement, "by promoting the sport and creating a passion for soccer in order to "Enjoy The Beautiful Game"."

This will help to enforce the LCYSA Parental Code of Conduct, "It is within the rights of a coach, official or club representative to ask you to leave if your behavior warrants it. *Failure to comply will be handled by the Club or County President.*"
